Sub: *Special Development Fund for MLAs – Utilization of fund for providing drinking water facilities in colonies - Clarification issued - Regarding.*

Ref: *G.O. (P) No. 247/04/Fin dated 27.05.2004.*

The guidelines for implementation of the scheme of Special Development Fund for MLAs as laid down in G.O. (P) No. 247/04/Fin dated 27.05.2004 (Appendix 1, item 19) permits work on civic amenities like electricity, water, pathways, public toilets etc. in slum areas of cities, towns and villages and in SC/ST habitations. Some of the members of the Legislative Assembly have brought to the notice of the Government the need to adopt a general policy by which SDF for MLAs could be used for providing drinking water facilities to all weaker sections, of the society residing in colonies, slums, etc.

2. Government, having considered the question in detail, clarify that the clause in the guidelines on the Special Development Fund for MLAs permitting expenditure on civic amenities, being met from the Fund, will be applicable to slums, colonies, etc. with non SC/ST population also.
