ORDER

As per the Government Order read 1st paper above, revised guidelines were issued for the selection of accredited agencies and for the execution of public works. In the Government Order read 2nd paper above, a Committee was constituted for advising Government on the selection and accreditation of agencies eligible for the execution of public works and prescribed the eligibility conditions for giving accreditation. As per the Government Orders read 4th and 5th above, subsequent modification to the revised guidelines were issued. In the Government Order read as 6th paper, Government have revised the monetary ceilings in total cost of works at hand and maximum cost of a single work to be taken up by each class of accredited agencies.

2. Government have reviewed the existing guidelines and found that certain conditions prescribed in the existing guidelines need

further modification for streamlining the execution of public works through the accredited agencies in the changed situation.

3. In the above circumstance, Government are pleased to issue the following modifications in the existing guidelines for the selection and execution of public works through accredited agencies.

- i. The monetary limit prescribed in para (3) of the Government Order read 6th above relating to the cost of total works to be taken up by the accredited agencies for execution at a time, stands modified as the total cost of works eligible to be taken up by the accredited agencies newly in a financial year.
- ii. Those agencies getting lower score in the evaluation process will also be considered for execution of low value public works having estimate cost of less than Rs. 50 lakh, provided the accreditation committee is convinced of their technical competence for execution of works without outsourcing. In such cases the work shall be permitted within the district of their sphere of activity.
- iii. When the accredited agencies are outsourcing the execution of assigned work or sub contracting, the selection of bidders shall be done purely on the basis of e-tendering and for that purpose, the agencies will be given registration in the e-procurement portal of Government.
- iv. New works can be entrusted only with the Agencies having valid accreditation. However, the agencies who had valid accreditation at the time of signing the

agreement can go ahead with the execution of the work if it is otherwise in order.

- v. Hereafter, the validity of accreditation will be for two years. The Chief Technical Examiner will conduct a technical review on the performance of the Agencies during the period of accreditation, three months before the expiry of the period of accreditation.
