ORDER

Government had opened a non-interest bearing Special Treasury Savings Bank Account (STSB A/c No.242) in the designation of Joint Secretary, Finance (Planning-A) Department with District Treasury, Thiruvananthapuram for parking the amount released under the Rubber Production Incentive Scheme (RPIS) and for the periodical sanction of the amount required for disbursing the subsidy to the bank account of the rubber farmers on receipt of claims under the scheme as per Government Order read as 2nd paper above. It has come to the notice that difficulties are being experienced in operating the above STSB account in the absence of Joint Secretary in charge of Finance (Planning-A) Department which in turn adversely affect the timely disbursal of subsidy to the rubber farmers.

Government after examining the matter are pleased to authorise Additional Secretary / Joint Secretary / Deputy Secretary / Under Secretary in charge of Finance (Planning-A) Department to operate the Special TSB account (STSB A/c No.242) so as to ensure the timely disbursal of subsidy to the rubber farmers.


