ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 2nd paper above, orders have been issued revising pay and allowances of State Government Employees and Teachers, wherein Risk allowance at varying rates has been sanctioned to various categories of employees considering the risk factor involved in the discharge of duties attached to their posts. The State Police Chief vide his letter read above has reported that Risk Allowance which was allowed to different categories of employees in Forensic Science Laboratory during the 9th Pay Revision vide G.O read as 1st above, has been discontinued with the implementation of 10th Pay Revision. He has reported that the employees in Forensic Science Laboratory deal with hazardous chemicals and explosive substances which are highly dangerous and it make them vulnerable to health hazards and there is enough justification to sanction Risk allowance to various categories of employees in Forensic Science Laboratory. Hence he has requested to restore the Risk allowance at revised rates to employees working in Forensic Science Laboratory.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to sanction Risk Allowance to the following categories of employees in Forensic Science Laboratory at the following rates.

Joint Director/Assistant Director	150
Ballistic Expert/Scientific Assistant /Photographer	150
Head Accountant/Junior Superintendent	120
Laboratory Technician	120
Confidential Assistant/Clerk/Typist	100
Mechanic	100
Police Driver/Technical Assistant/Office Attendant	100
