**ORDER**

As per the Notification read above, Government of India have introduced a new restructured defined contributory pension system, namely 'New Pension Scheme' for the employees recruited to Central Government Services (except Armed Forces) on or after 01/01/2004 replacing the existing system of defined pension scheme.

2. Accordingly, State Government are pleased to make the scheme applicable to the All India Service officers recruited to Kerala Cadre on or after 01/01/2004.

3. Detailed guidelines in this regard will be issued separately.
