ORDER

As per the Government Order read above, the Government have dispensed with the Self Drawing Officer (SDO) System and introduced One Office One DDO System in the State. This envisages drawal and disbursement of salary and other entitlements of all employees, including gazetted officers by the Drawing and Disbursing Officers (DDO) of the establishment in which the officers are attached to.

The Registrar General of High Court vide reference second cited intimated that Hon'ble Chief Justice and Judges of the High Court desires to draw their salary and other entitlements through SDO system continued hitherto. It was also reported that Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and many other High Courts follow this system.

In view of the above, Government are pleased to exempt drawal of salary and other entitlements of Hon'ble Judges of the High Court from the purview of the Government Order read above.

Director of Treasuries shall issue necessary direction to the treasury officer concerned immediately.
