ENHANCEMENT OF THE MONETARY LIMIT FOR SUBMISSION OF UTILIZATION CERTIFICATE IN RESPECT OF GRANT IN AID GIVEN BY GOVERNMENT TO VARIOUS INSTITUTIONS - ORDERS -ISSUED

**ORDER**

The Article 210(1) of the Kerala Financial Code, envisages that utilization certificates relating to grants-in -aid sanctioned by Government to various institutions for an amount not exceeding Rs.10,000/-shall be submitted to the Head of Department and if the amount exceeds this limit, the same shall be submitted to the Accountant General(A&E).The Accountant General vide reference cited has requested to examine enhancement of the monetary ceiling since the above limit was fixed long ago and the value of the rupee has increased many folds since then.

2.In these circumstances, the Government are pleased to order enhancement of the monetary limit to Rs.2, 00,000/- from the existing level of Rs. 10,000/-. Hereafter utilisation certificates in respect of grant in aid sanctioned by Government to various institutions up to Rs. 2 lakh shall be submitted to the Head of Department and amount in excess of Rs. 2 lakh shall be submitted to Accountant General(A&E).

3.This order will take effect in respect of all grant in aid sanctioned from April 2016 onwards.
