**ORDER**

1. Government vide orders read 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> above, revised pay and allowances and pensionary benefits of State Govt. employees, staff to educational institutions, teachers, University employees etc. As per order read 3<sup>rd</sup> above Government have modified the procedure for fixing the re employment pay under the Rule 100, Part III KSR.

2. In para 13 of the order read 2<sup>nd</sup> above, it has been stated that revision of re employment pay shall be issued separately. Accordingly Govt. are pleased to revise the re employment pay in respect of those who retired and re-employed prior to 01.07.2014 and still continuing, their re employment pay will be revised in accordance with the principles laid down herein .

(i) Existing Re employment pay

- (ii) DA at 80% of Re-employment pay (i.e. of (i) )
- (iii) Fitment benefit at 18% of Re-employment pay (i.e. of (i) )
- (iv) The amount so arrived, as rounded off to the next higher rupee, will be regarded as revised re employment pay with effect from 01.07.2014.
- (v) They are eligible for admissible DA on re-employment pay with effect from 01.07.2014.
- (vi) They are also eligible for revised pension and admissible DR on pension with effect from 01.07.2014.
- (vi) They are also eligible for HRA and CCA applicable from time to time on the pay at the time of retirement.
- (vii) The arrears of revision of re-employment pay and pension, if any, shall be paid as per para 9 of the order read 2<sup>nd</sup> above.

3. The revised re employment pay will be fixed by the Accountant General in the case of Gazetted Officers and by the DDO concerned in the case of non gazetted officers. For this a form of undertaking as prescribed in G.O read 4 above shall be furnished. The undertaking shall be countersigned by the Drawing and Disbursing Officer in all cases and shall be forwarded to the Accountant General in the case of Gazetted Officers.


