S. R. O. No. 393/2016.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala, hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Service Rules, namely:—

RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Service (Fourth Amendment) Rules, 2016.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 2014.

2. *Amendment of the Rules.*—In Part III of the Kerala Service Rules, in rule 90,—

(1) in sub-rule (2) clause (f) shall be omitted;

(2) for sub-rule (11), the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“(11) Widow/Widower of the Government employee governed by these rules will not be entitled to family pension under any other rules except family pension granted from the Defence Department and Extraordinary pension admissible under the rules in Appendix XIII of Part III of this rules”.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Government of India have decided to allow two family pensions where the pensioner draw, is drawing or may draw two pension for military and/or civil employment as per Office Memorandum OM No. 1/33/2012-P&PW(E), Ministry of Personnel, P.G. & Pensions, Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare dated 16th January, 2013 of Government of India. The Accountant General (A&E) Kerala sought clarification whether Government of Kerala intends to extend the benefit to State family pensioners also. Moreover, several representations have been received from various corners seeking the benefit. Hence vide G. O. (P) No. 427/2014/Fin. dated 30th September, 2014, Government have ordered to allow two family pensions where the pensioner draw, is drawing or may draw two pensions for military and/or civil employments on or after the 1st day of January, 1964 with monetary benefit with effect from 1st day of October, 2014 and to make necessary amendments in rule 90 of Part III of the Kerala Service Rules.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
