ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1st paper above, orders have been issued revising pay and allowances of State Government Employees and Teachers and ordered inter alia to revise the Special Allowance of Personal Staff of Chief Minister, Other Ministers, Leader of Opposition, Speaker, Deputy Speaker and Government Chief Whip. Eventhough the Personal Staff of Speaker, Deputy Speaker and Chairmen of Financial Committees are eligible for Special Allowance under Rule 7(1) of the 'Personal Staff of the Speaker, Deputy Speaker and Chairmen of Financial Committees Rules-1987' at the same rate as admissible to Personal Staff of Ministers, Leader of Opposition and Government Chief Whip, the rate of Special Allowance sanctioned to the Personal Staff of Speaker, Deputy Speaker and Chairmen of Financial Committees is at a lower rate than that sanctioned to Personal Staff of Ministers, Leader of Opposition and Government Chief Whip. The Legislature Secretariat vide G.O read as 2nd above have issued orders in excercise of powers under Rule 7(3)of the 'Personal Staff of the Speaker, Deputy Speaker and Chairmen of Financial Committees Rules-1987' revising the rate of Special allowance of Personal Staff of Speaker, Deputy Speaker and Chairmen of Financial Committees at par with the rate existig for Personal Staff of Ministers, Leader of Opposition and Government Chief Whip.

2.The Secretary, Legislature Secretariat has reported that, the Accountant General has not authorized Special Allowance at revised rate sanctioned in the G.O read as 2nd above observing that the action of Legislature Secretariat in modifying the orders issued by Finance Department without consulting them is not in order. Therefore the Secretary, Legislature Secretariat has requested to ratify the order issued in G.O read 2nd above.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to ratify the orders issued by the Legislature Secretariat vide G.O read as 2nd above.
